ONE WEEK OUT! Here are updates from our SEVENTH day!

#1 –OUR MESSAGE WAS HEARD LOUD AND CLEAR AT CITY HALL!

- Hundreds of us filled the chambers at City Hall yesterday to tell our story.
- The City Council unanimously passed a resolution in support of our strike. It says: “the Detroit City Council supports working people across every sector of our economy and recognizes that working people deserve respect, adequate workplace protections, and the right to a living wage.”
- The City Council also says it will provide a copy of its resolution to each of the three casinos! We also got amazing press coverage from the event.

#2 – MORE SOLIDARITY FROM UNION WORKERS ACROSS THE COUNTRY!

- The Communications Workers of America cancelled an event they were having at MotorCity starting 11/1.
- Casino workers in Biloxi, Mississippi met with our strikers today by Zoom.
- Clergy – including pastors and priests from many denominations visited our lines.

#3 – WE ARE GETTING BETTER ORGANIZED AND STRONGER EVERY DAY. EACH OF US HAS A ROLE TO PLAY.

- Look out for text updates on negotiations. The mediator has called us back to the table on Thursday.
